To be eligible for the award of 22235VIC Certificate I in General Education for Adults (Introductory), learners must successfully complete a total of 11 units comprising:

- Core 2 units
- Core skills reading 3 units
- Core skills writing 3 units
- Core skills numeracy and mathematics 4 units
- Special interest electives 4 units
