



Certificate I in Transition Education provides learners who have low literacy and numeracy skills the opportunity to build confidence and better engage with employment, community, learning and personal domains.

The focus of the curriculum is to enable learners to find the most appropriate options for them in the community while engaging in further training after leaving school.

This may include employment, volunteer work or further study.
